ENTRY INTO A MATERIAL DEFINITIVE AGREEMENT.

On November 2, 2005, the Pacific Exchange, Inc. (PCX), a Delaware corporation and wholly owned subsidiary of Archipelago Holdings, Inc., a Delaware corporation, entered into an indemnity agreement (Agreement) with The Options Clearing Corporation (OCC) a Delaware corporation. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit 2.1. The description of the Agreement as set forth herein is qualified in its entirety by reference to the full text of the Agreement.

Brief Description of the Material Terms and Conditions of the Amendment

Under the terms of the Agreement, PCX will indemnify OCC for any third party claim made in connection with the clearing activity of OCC undertaken as part of its clearing arrangement with PCX; and OCC will issue options on exchange traded funds listed and traded on the Pacific Exchange and clear those trades in accordance with its clearing arrangement with PCX.

Relationship of the Parties

PCX owns a 20% equity interest in OCC.
