Item 3.01 Notice of Delisting or Failure to Satisfy a Continued Listing Rule or Standard; Transfer of Listing

On April 20, 2005, Orion received a letter from the American Stock Exchange notifying Orion that it does not meet the Exchange's continued listing standards because Orion is not in compliance with Section 134 and 1101 of the Amex Company Guide. The non-compliance results from the Company's failure to file

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its Annual Report on Form 10-KSB for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2004 by the extended filing deadline of April 15, 2005. The Exchange has given Orion until May 2, 2005 to file the Form 10-KSB and regain compliance with the Amex requirements.

Orion believes that by filing the Form 10-KSB by May 2, 2005, it will regain compliance with the Amex requirements.

Attached is a copy of a press release issued on April 26, 2005, by Orion regarding the Exchange action. Also attached is a copy of the Exchange's April 20 letter to the Company.
