S&T Bancorp, Inc. ("S&T") expects its second quarter of 2018 results will be negatively affected by a credit loss arising from a participation loan agreement with a lead bank and other participating banks, all of which extended multiple credit facilities to a single, large commercial customer. The loss resulted from fraudulent activities believed to be perpetrated by one or more executives employed by the borrower and its related entities. S&T's total exposure consists of the participation loan of \$4.9 million and a direct exposure of \$950 thousand which is secured by vehicles and equipment liens. S&T is continuing to evaluate the matter and currently estimates that the loss will be in the range of \$4.5 million to \$5.4 million.
