As previously disclosed, on February 1, 2012, El Paso Electric Company (the “Company”) filed a request with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to increase base rates. The request was made in response to a resolution adopted by the El Paso City Council requiring the Company to show cause why its base rates for customers should not be reduced. The State Office of Administrative Hearings recently established a procedural schedule that would allow for hearings in June 2012. On April 4, 2012, the Company filed a motion with the State Office of Administrative Hearings for indefinite suspension of the procedural schedule to facilitate settlement discussions. The motion was supported by all parties to the proceeding. The Administrative Law Judge granted the motion for indefinite suspension on April 6, 2012. As a result of the order, all aspects of the proceedings, including all procedural and discovery deadlines, are suspended. The Company will not comment further on the status of settlement discussions among the parties but will publicly report any material developments at the appropriate time.
