The performance period for the restricted stock units was January 1, 2017 until December 31, 2017, with vesting subject to approval of the performance calculation by the Issuer's

- (6) Compensation Committee. This approval was obtained on January 29, 2018. As a result, one-third (1/3) of the restricted stock units vested on February 17, 2018, and the remaining two-thirds (2/3) of the restricted stock units will vest in equal quarterly installments over eight (8) subsequent quarters.
